Dear friends,

Since many of you asked about our trip to Germany in May and Esther's and Wolfgang's wedding, we thought to send a short newsletter.



Yes, the trip was a blessing and a miracle at the same time, especially because Philippus did very well, although it had been so difficult with him in January.

After all the small miracles and experiences during the week and our amazement at God's wonderful provision right to the smallest details, **our daughter's wedding day** was the highlight of the week.



We had a wonderful time of fellowship and even though we met Egon and Marga, Esther's parents in law, for the first time, we realized once again: You are **at home** when you are among the children of God.

Back in Scharosch we concluded **our first year in our discipleship school**. Roland Wieser, Pastor of the Eschweiler Church was there and we enjoyed the good fellowship as well as the sharing times and playing volleyball and bible quizzes. It is always a little like **family life**, when we spend three days together and most of them want to start the second year = leadership school this coming fall.

Last week we had a child evangelism week with a **team from Illertissen, the good shepherd church**.

We were impressed by their **fire of prayer** and their **childlike faith**, in which they took every small and big request to God and also by the miracles we experienced afterwards: Even though rain had been forecasted, the sun came out and we were able to walk to pick up the children from two different neighborhoods (more than 70 on one afternoon), we played outside after worship and bible stories. The rain continued only after we had taken the children home.

We were also able to visit the parents of many children and prayed with them. We were surprised to see some of them in our Sunday service as well.

On our last day we celebrated the "**Children of the King**" party, with all children wearing white linen cloths and each of them received a beautiful crown, that had been crafted by the team and a Romanian children's bible with coloring pictures.





Prayer requests:

- **Our two camps** we plan for August. A Royal Rangers Team from the Senden church have announced their coming for the **kid's camp** (for the 9-13 year olds). They want to serve our children.
The **Teenager Camp** (for the 14-18 year olds) will be led by the young people from Bramsche.
We thank God for the many volunteers coming here to serve those often very poor children and teenagers. They sacrifice a lot of time, but God rewards them wonderfully.

- We would like to build a **pool**. We will have several more camps from other churches and we thought that a pool would be nice for the children to cool off. We have saved some money for it already, but we would appreciate any additional donation.

- We are scheduling **the new discipleship school year** for September. Please pray for those to register, that have already been prepared by God.

- With God's grace, we plan **our Disciple mission trip** from July 13th to 17th. We want to travel to Bacau (Moldova) with the graduates of the first year and serve with a church planting ministry there through evangelistic outreaches and practical work with the families.

- **Elisabeth and Rolf Reinhardt** from the Good Shepherd Church in Illertsen, who have already supported many poor families with potatoes or **heart packages** with school materials for those children who cannot afford to go to school, are planning to move to Romania = Fagaras in August. Please pray for us to find a good house for them.

- **Margit**, our sister with open legs has been in Germany for nearly 9 months, where David, the wound specialist has been bandaging her every fourth day. The big wounds are getting better, new skin is growing at the edges. Today they tested her blood circulation. It is running well through the arteria, but only very slowly through the veins (backflow). She will be admitted to the hospital soon, to scratch off the scab close to the new skin under general anaesthesia. Please pray for everything to go well, for the healing to proceed and that God will give her resilience.

- Yesterday we started a **new homegroup in the "Malotanta" district**. Ever since the outreach of the Illertissen Team, there is a new breakthrough in the district. A few adults are very open. Please pray for God to create a true breakthrough in their hearts, so that people get to know Him personally.
