It was hard work but Edwin, Jhony and Angel and others done it joyfully. The next stage is the construction and this is where you come in. You will already have received our urgent appeal to help with my hospital bill. We have received some pledges for help, and still need your help in paying this large bill. The operation was a success and at the time of writing I have only a little pain from the operation. I was put under three weeks of not moving my head and no driving which has had hindered me for a while from ministry and I am so looking forward to working especially with the evangelism team. I want to thank this wonderful woman Christa who is my wife (we celebrated 30 years marriage in September) who has stood by me through sickness and health. I know it has not been easy for her, so I am especially grateful for her love and care for me. Friends, time is so short before the return of the Lord Jesus Christ and yet there are thousands, if not millions of people who have never even heard of the name of Jesus. How can we stand by and do nothing, especially when Jesus ORDERED us to share the Good News? My heart cries out for those lost, and I cannot stop sharing. Evangelism

Our team goes out each week covering each house one by one where they share the Gospel. We make a point in each house asking if we can pray for their needs. More than often than not, we are invited in and see the many needs of the family as well as praying for their health. They are grateful that we care for them and that is how we win the lost for Jesus. When the local YWAM has teams, they too come and help us evangelize.

Local Post Office

Our local post office has been closed now for over two months. The contract ran out and nobody in Government even thought about how it would continue to run. The only country in Latin America without a post office! Can you believe it? Meanwhile at the time of writing over 2,000 sacks of mail in customs is awaiting delivery. We know that we have a packet and some mail among those sacks. For the time being we ask you not to write to our address in Guatemala, but to email us. Sadly, my lovely postcards have had to stop. Let us pray that is will reopen soon.

Support



We have to speak about money again! On 1st November it will be exactly 23 years here in Guatemala. Until the beginning of this year, our support had nominally been pretty much the same. These last few months, however, it has dropped noticeably. This, as well as the fact that prices have risen a hundredfold since 1993 and that the exchange rate for the euro and the US Dollar have gone down a lot, have caused a pretty drastic fall in our finances, which in turn affects both our private life as well as our ministry. We already wrote above about the big project of the church building. But what is also affected is the personal help for people in our church, who need

help with different needs (mostly for health/medical needs, food, clothing or schooling etc).

Therefore we would like to ask you to ask the Lord in prayer if He may want to use you to supply our need. God called us here, and for 23 years, we have fulfilled His call with our ministry. We will continue to do so, for woe is us if we do not fulfill the call of God. And God – through you – will determine the extent of it.
