**"And he has inspired him to teach." Exodus 35:34**

**Hello my dears!**

I was completely surprised by this verse in my daily Bible reading. Bezalel and Oholiab were the two men God had chosen to build the tabernacle. Among other important abilities, they are said to have the gift of "teaching". In the Greek original text the word "to teach" means to help younger people become able to cope with life. Perhaps in other words = multiplicative discipleship.

**On our farm** spring has come with might. Finally!!! We've been waiting for it for sooooo long. It is visible not only in the fact that the snow is gone now since one week, but also that our pets are getting their offspring. **The goat has thrown 2 kids**, 4 others are preparing for it, and our **horse Nora expects her foal in March**, our **3 bunnies in April**, then **Samy**, our **bitch** and lastly **Herta the cow**.

In addition, the **construction work** has started again: in the house of the wood centre, where we already had one room, a kitchen and bathroom downstairs, we want to convert 2 more rooms in the attic to have more space for guests. Tomorrow, windows and doors are installed and next week the staircase will be delivered which leads up to the entrance door on the outside.

**In our church**, we feel the same atmosphere of change as on the farm. We are jam-packed, we consider how to create more space (or maybe to have two worship services on Sunday), but it is a wonderful development in the house groups, in the youth group as well as in **the children's meeting where Elisabeth = the children's missionary from Illertissen**, is fully engaged (she and her husband Rolf have moved to Fogarasch last year). She has a lot of experience, good material but also a passion for Jesus and for the children and that makes the children's meetings (on Thursday evening + Sunday morning) very exciting.

Even though there is a lot of resistance and sometimes a real struggle from within (the church) and from outside (the authorities), we are overwhelmed to see that there is a **ripe harvest**, that always new people come, or those who did not come for a long time suddenly are back in church. Even the young teenagers from non-Christian homes arrive on Sunday mornings at 9:30 am in flocks.



Two Sundays ago, the aunt of one of our girls, who had hitherto raged very much against the "converts", came to the service. She was very touched during the worship time, and then came to the front to get prayed for towards the end. Michael blessed her wholeheartedly without knowing a precise prayer subject. A week later, she told us that she had no back pain anymore and felt very comfortable. She brought her son with her and said her brother with wife also wanted to come.

We see the same **openness** in **Gura Văii**. Apart from the 5 families who have been around for a while, new people are coming.

We believe that in the summer of this year we can start with services. The church of Rosenau donated 250 Euros already. We still need 750 Euros to complete the roof and then windows and doors are to be installed.

God has laid it on our hearts to start a church in this village. A young family who has got a piece of land from the mayor's office to build a small house, wants to give us the lower area (the 4 walls are already standing) as a church facility and to build their own home up in the attic. **Margit, our sister with the ulcerated legs** is back at home since 30th November. Her time in Germany (1 year and 3 months) was very valuable. Thanks to the wonderful **hospitality** and **helpfulness of David and Marlis Krumbacher**, who genuinely accepted her into their own family during this year and thanks to the company which donated these expensive compresses and dressings and thanks to the medical care, iron, protein and other medicine donated the **healing on her legs** could make visible progress. The swelling of the legs subsided and new skin has grown over a large area. In the pictures you can see how the legs look like after her time there.

Since the legs are not yet healed, and since a skin transplant is very risky in her case, because her blood flow is very bad due of the weak veins, we are still dependent on these **expensive compresses = Durafiber + Aquacell** and the **absorbent dressing pads** since the wound is very wet and runny.

In regular pharmacies the compresses cost 100 Euros / pack, containing 5 Durafiber 15x15cm. For a wound dressing she needs 3 Durafiber, 3 Aquacell 15x15 and 3-4 smaller pieces to cover the two wounds. We have found a wholesale pharmacy in Austria selling at a lower price. A pack of Durafiber only costs 45 Euros.

It still is a lot of money and since she does not tolerate anything else at the moment and we do not want to fall back into the old state, we are really dependent on God's grace and donations for them.

At the beginning of February, **our discipleship school** had its third meeting of this new school year. It was a good time where a proper foundation was laid. For the next meeting in spring, we are expecting the family Werner and Linda Kempkens, who will teach us the basics of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and also about prophetic evangelism. At the end of January we had a very good marriage workshop where an American couple taught us principles for counselling in marriage problems.
