CELEBRATIONS IN GUATEMALA





The 1st of November is a special day in Guatemala. It is the Day of the Dead, where families visit the cemeteries and lay flowers on the graves of their loved ones. They then spend the rest of the day sitting on the graves and having a picnic with loud music blaring from the many music centers or guitars they have brought with them. As they leave they also lay food on the graves in the hope their love ones will eat it during the nighttime. In truth, the street people climb over the walls and have a great feast!





unique part of this Guatemalan tradition is the kite festival. This is a spectacular display of extravagantly enormous, brightly colored kites that fill the sky. Locals say that these huge kites are used as a way to connect with the deceased, and these kites take over the skies in the towns of Santiago and Sumpango, where the largest kite festivals take place. They might take a whole year to build these kites and it can take up to 4 men to keep the flights from disappearing into the skies with them attached to it if they are not careful.

JEFF'S HEALTH

This month, Jeff, went to see a very famous neurosurgeon in Houston, Texas to get a second opinion. The contact had been wonderfully arranged by Jeff's Pain Specialist Doctor here in Guatemala and also through very efficient lady also here in Guatemala. One of my FaceBook friends, Dolly Cruise who lives in Houston had also arranged a hotel suite close to the hospital, for me free of charge for 3 nights! It was wonderful to actually meet her. She helped me find my way around the huge hospital, and after the doctor's visit we ate lunch together. Who says you cannot find real friends on FB?

Dr. Holman, the neurosurgeon, at the end gave me the same report as the surgeon here in Guatemala last September: it would take at least three very difficult surgeries that would be guaranteed to cause complications and maybe even death. He also said that my condition would worsen, which we are already observing! More or less I had expected such a thing, but I wanted to catch up with this second opinion in order to have full certainty.

Now we believe in a second miracle similar to that of 1991 when I was instantly healed when an evangelist laid hands on me and prayed for me. That happened in the presence of 200 witnesses, including our current director of Globe Mission, Andreas Pestke. I recently received an e-mail from a Catholic friend who was my Spanish teacher a long time ago. She told me about a dream in which she saw me getting out of a wheelchair and dancing and laughing. I know that God also uses other people to validate a promise God also made to my wife, Christa, that I will soon be completely healed. Hallelujah! God is so good! God is still on His throne! I continue to testify and continue to preach in the church. As long as I have a voice, I will not stop. Thank you Jesus!
