## Volcano Fuego Tragedy

Since the 3<sup>rd</sup> June this has been an ongoing work and will continue for many months to come. Between 2,500 and 3,000 people were buried alive in this terrible tragedy and, sadly, the Government will not admit to that many people dying. It is strange that they are now carrying out a census of the whole of Guatemala. To date, and with the help of your donations, we have helped to kit out at 10 families with everything from clothes, shoes, food, toiletries, bedding, pots & pans, crockery, kitchen utensils, cutlery, medicines and money. Many lost not only some of their families, but also their houses. We want to share one of the many miracles that I heard from different survivors. Don Pedro and his family of 10 jumped into their pickup truck as soon as they heard and saw ashes and rocks falling around them. As they drove over a river the vehicle stalled and would not start. The pyroclastic heated ash was moving at 60 MPH, and had begun to envelope and smother them, so they prayed and suddenly the vehicle burst into life again! Although covered in ash they escaped with their lives. Don Pedro told me that he knew God had saved their lives. Some good news among the terrible news indeed!
