-> she decides not to leave someone in great need  
-> she invests love and loyalty into a relationship that won't repay her  
-> she is willing to leave her country, her relatives, her friends for someone who has become a role model to her.  
-> she gave up her own live – to be **rewarded by the living God.**

**Dear friends,**

This biblical story has been fascinating me for weeks. Since January our church has been studying the biographies of great men and women in the Old Testament. The last two Sundays we studied Ruth. God proving his faithfulness is remarkable – when a person stays with him selflessly and full of trust.

**Our Family** is doing very well, praise God. We have finished our fall chores: We harvested and cleaned our garden to be fertilized and ploughed soon. The barn is filled with hay to provide for our two horses, the cow and the rabbits during the winter. We brought wood in from the forest, cut and piled it. We harvested the few apples (there was hardly any fruit this

year), cooked plum jam and stored the jars in the cellar, pickled cucumbers, tomatoes and peppers.

Now we will only have to pickle the cabbage and we will be ready for the winter.



**Philippus** has been doing very well. He is less stressed and goes to bed by himself again, he sleeps by himself in his own room and has not had epileptic seizures for half a year. He develops an interest to learn how to write and looks forward to the start of Elisabeth's "Afterschool-program" that he is going to attend.

**The Church** enjoys great services and new people as well as cell group meetings during the week. We are trying to involve those with discipleship and leadership training in our different ministries to learn responsibility. We handed over leadership of a cell group in "Combinat" a district in the outskirts of Fagaras) to a self-reliant leader and four weeks ago we started a new cell group in town and our goal is to hand it over to two young women after six months (one responsible for worship, one for processing the Sunday preaching). **Baptism:** By the grace of God we were able to baptize six people at the end of July. It was a real church party on our farm again.



**Our Teenagers** are a great joy. Four of them were able to attend a two week Ranger Camp in Senden in July where they received vision. After our two camps in August, where they served as co-workers, they are now taking turns to prepare the Teenager meetings on Sunday afternoons.



They serve the Teenagers through teachings (we are talking about the parables Jesus told), games and food. We support them by meeting with them during the week to prepare the Sunday meetings.
