The worst hit areas were towards the coast, where some houses were completely destroyed. September is the month of quite a few storms and heavy rain.

Christa is doing fine, but has the normal body aches with her age. I am now having physiotherapy once a week, and the daily exercises have already yielded physical changes. Our physiotherapist comes every Saturday to monitor my progress. She is an excellent teacher and is not pushing me too hard. I, myself, overdone the exercises one day and suffered the next! There is a lesson to learn—patience! What pleases me more than anything is that I do not believe an operation is necessary.
